

EMC'14 General Information

1. Free doughnuts and waffles will be available on a first-come, first-served basis for all the EMC'14/Tokyo registrants, guests, and their accompanying persons during the coffee break in the "Conversation Room" on the 2nd floor of the symposium venue from May 13 to 16.
2. Free drink service will be available at the "Coffee Service" tables (see the floor layout on the last page of the "Program").
3. No food is allowed in the foyers of the symposium venue. Please eat "inside the rooms" or "outside the building."
4. Proceedings data in a CD-R is available at the Registration Desk for PCs without a USB port. Please bring your own PC with your nametag on, and you can copy the data into your PC at or near the Registration Desk.
5. Smoking is not allowed inside the building of the symposium venue, except in the "Smoking Room" on the 2nd floor.
6. There are some vending machines for hot and cold drinks in the symposium venue.
7. There are no coin-operated lockers in Hitotsubashi Hall, so the symposium attendees should not bring too many belongings.
8. There are a lot of shops and restaurants at "Palaceside Arcade," adjacent to Takebashi Station, which is only 5 minutes away from the symposium venue on foot, and will be one of the best places to eat around this area (see the website of Palaceside Arcade for further information: <http://www.mai-b.co.jp/index-en.html>)
There is also a cafeteria on the 3rd floor of the symposium venue (the National Center of Sciences), but it will be very crowded during the lunchtime. We recommend eating out at restaurants for lunch.
9. There is a copy machine on the 2nd floor of the symposium venue. The fee for making a copy is 10 Japanese yen (JPY) per sheet for black and white copies, and 50 JPY for color copies.
