Abstract

The proceedings will be printed directly from camera-ready copy furnished by the authors. To ensure that all papers in the publication have a uniform appearance, authors should conform to the following instructions. This is example of the abstract.

1 Length of Papers and Manuscript Due Date

Final manuscripts including the title and paper description should not exceed **5 pages** of A4 format in English marked with a header of title and authors' names.

Camera ready due: 3 August 2001

2 Output Style and Format

Your paper must be printed in black-and-white on A4 white paper.

Papers must be printed in the two-column format. The paper margins should be as follows:

Top margin: 2 cm

Left margin: 2 cm

Right margin: 2 cm

Bottom margin: 3 cm

To ensure maximum readability, your paper must include two columns. There should be 0.5 cm gutter of white space between the two columns. Text should be 10-point Times New Roman.

Do not print or write page numbers on the front of your paper.

3 Title

The title appears near the top of the first page, centered over both columns in 16-point Bold type Times New Roman. Author's names should appear below the title of the paper in 12-point Times New Roman, along with affiliation(s), complete address(es) and E-mail address(es). You should begin the two-column format when you come to the abstract.

4 Heading and Sections (not mandatory)

When necessary, headings should be used to separate major sections of your paper. First-level heads should be 12-point bold type, flush left, with two blank lines before them and one afterwards. Paragraphs are indented 0.5 cm. There is no blank line between paragraphs. I may want a numbered subsection, which is done as follows.

4.1 Subsections

Second-level headings should be 11-point bold type, flush left, with one blank line before them and one afterwards.

4.1.1 Sub-subsections

Third-level headings should be 10-point bold type, flush left, with one blank line before them and one afterwards.

5 Figures and Tables

Provide figures with their captions within the text as follows: See Table 1 or Figure 1.

All illustrations and pictures should be high-contrast black and white (not color) prints.

6 Citation and References (not mandatory)

References should be cited of the form [1] or [2] at the end of the paper. The numbers are based on the order they appear in the text.
