

## Setting up usage environment (Internet Browser)

### Enable the use of Java Script

#### Internet Explorer (for Windows)

When changing "Security level"

1. Click "Internet options" in the "Tool" menu at the top of the browser.
2. Click the "Security" tab.
3. Turn the "Security level of this zone" knob to "Middle," and click on the "OK" button.  
(If this knob is not displayed, click on the "Pre-set level" button.)

When customizing "Security level"

1. Click on "Internet option" in the "Tool" menu at the top of the browser.
2. Click on the "Security" tab.
3. Click on the "Level customizing" button.
4. Check "Enable" in "Active script" and click on the "OK" button.
5. Click on the "OK" button.

#### Safari (for Mac)

1. Click on "Preference" in menu at the top of the browser.
2. Click on the "Security" tab.
3. Check "Enable JavaScript" button.

### Enable Cookies

#### Internet Explorer (for Windows)

When changing "Privacy settings"

1. Click on "Internet option" in the "Tool" menu at the top of the browser.
2. Click on the "Privacy" tab.
3. Turn the "Security Privacy level of this zone" knob to "Middle-High," and click on the "OK" button.  
(If this knob is not displayed, click on the "Pre-set level" button.)

When customizing "Privacy settings"

1. In Internet Explorer, click on "Internet option" in the "Tool" menu at the top of the browser.
2. Click on the "Privacy" tab.
3. Click on the "Detail settings" button.
4. Check "Overwrite automatic cookie processing."
5. Check "Always permit session cookie" and click on the "OK" button.
6. Click on the "OK" button.

#### Safari (for Mac)

1. Click on "Preference" in menu at the top of the browser.
2. Click on the "Privacy" tab.
3. Check "Never" button on "Block cookies."
