

Student Expense Grants for ICSANE  
(International Conference on Space, Aeronautical and Navigational Electronics)

## 1 Purpose

- The steering committee on ICSANE supports a total or a part of expenses (travel and registration fees) to ICSANE for some students who desire to have presentations in ICSANE.
- The number of student presentations is increased by providing the grants, leading to the activation of the conference and our research fields.

## 2 Requirement of grant application

- University or graduate university students, who live one of the countries/areas in Asia (except Republic of Korea, Taiwan, China, Singapore, and Japan), Africa, Central America, and South America, corresponding to the countries/areas designated in Overseas Membership Development Program (OMDP) provided by IEICE. ([https://www.ieice.org/eng/join\\_ieice/index.html](https://www.ieice.org/eng/join_ieice/index.html))
- Presenters of oral or poster presentations
- Students who are difficult to attend ICSANE because of insufficient funding, in spite of achieving sufficient research results.
- The supervisors of the students must approve grant applications. The signature of the supervisor is required in an application form that can download from the ICSANE web site.

## 3 Application method

- Students, who want to receive the grants, submit the application form and camera-ready papers.
- The deadline of the grant application with the camera-ready papers is a month before the deadline of application for presentations.

## 4 Selection method

- Reviewers are selected by the ICSANE steering committee.
- The camera-ready papers of candidates are evaluated by the reviewers, and grade them on a scale of 5 points for each items, listed in section 5. Recipients are preferentially selected in the order of high score among the candidates.
- Selection results are informed to the candidates by a week before the deadline of the application for presentations.

## 5 Criteria of the selection

(1) Originality and creativity, (2) Novelty, (3) Technical correct and logical, (4) Impact, (5) Practical usefulness, (6) Quality of English and conciseness, (7) References\*

Scores range from 5 (Excellent), 3 (Moderate), and 1 (Less).

\* References are judged by the quality but not just numbers.

## **6 Expense of the grants**

- Totally up to ¥50,000 per year
- The number of recipients is not restricted.
- Total expenses are not necessarily provided.

## **7 Provision method of the grants**

- The steering committee provides the cash of the expense grants to the recipients at a reception desk in a venue after they finish their presentations.
