### Information for Authors

Manuscripts should be prepared according to the guidelines in the Information for Authors available at the IEICE Web site [http://www.ieice.org/eng/shiori/mokuji\\_ess.html](http://www.ieice.org/eng/shiori/mokuji_ess.html). Manuscript style specification can be found at the Web site (Section 3: Manuscript Style Specifications). The number of pages is strongly recommended to be 8 for a PAPER and 2 for a LETTER. A page has about 900 words.

### Submission

This special section will accept only papers by electronic submission. Prospective authors are requested to follow carefully the submission process described below.

1. Submit a paper using the IEICE Web site [https://review.ieice.org/regist\\_e.aspx](https://review.ieice.org/regist_e.aspx). Authors should choose [Special--EA] Cryptography and Information Security as "Type of Section (Issue) / Transactions" on the online screen. Do not choose [Regular--EA] Fundamentals.
2. Send "Copyright Transfer and Page Charge Agreement" and "Confirmation Sheet of Manuscript" to Dr. Takeshi Okamoto (secretary) by postal mail, FAX or Email.

ATTENTION: Please do not forget to send "Copyright Transfer and Page Charge Agreement" and "Confirmation Sheet of Manuscript." We cannot start the review process without them, even if we receive the manuscript. Note that the author with IEICE membership who paid their membership fee by credit card is required to write two signatures in the Copyright Transfer and Page Charge Agreement.

### Deadline

The deadline of Electronic submissions: March 23, 2010.

Note that "Copyright Transfer and Page Charge Agreement" and "Confirmation Sheet of Manuscript" must be received by this date.

### Notification

Acceptance or reject of the submitted papers or letters will be notified to the authors before middle of August 2010. Please note that if accepted, all authors, including authors of invited papers, will be requested to pay for the page charges covering partial cost of publication. 50 copies of reprints will be provided.
