# *Special Section on Recent Progress in Organic Molecular Electronics and Biotechnology*

The Institute of Electronics, Information and Communication Engineers (IEICE) Transactions on Electronics announces a forthcoming special section on “Recent Progress in Organic Molecular Electronics and Biotechnology” to be published in **February 2019**. Organic molecules are getting recognized as important materials for the electronics. IEICE has been publishing the special sections pertinent to this field biannually since 2000 to keep track of the progress achieved in the organic molecular electronics. This special section covers various aspects of organic materials and biotechnology. Their applications extend to such fields as transistors, memories, displays, photovoltaics, optical devices, energy devices, sensors, actuators, bioelectronics and medical application. The topics related to basic physics and chemistry, material development, process technologies, devices and applications are included in this issue. Not only the papers which are going to be presented at 10th International Symposium on Organic Molecular Electronics (ISOME 2018), scheduled on May 31-June 2, 2018 at Sun Messe Tosu in Tosu, but all other authors in the related fields are highly encouraged to contribute to this issue. ## 2. Submission Instructions

The deadline for submission is **June 15, 2018**. Manuscripts should be prepared according to the submission guideline for IEICE Transactions ([http://www.ieice.org/eng/shiori/mokuji\\_es.html](http://www.ieice.org/eng/shiori/mokuji_es.html)). Both Full Papers (standard 8 printed pages) and Brief Papers (up to 4 printed pages) are accepted. The term for revising the manuscript after acknowledgement of conditional acceptance for this special section could be shorter than that for regular issues (60 days) because of the tight review schedule. This special section will accept only papers by electronic submission. Prospective authors are requested to follow the procedure described below.
