

Makoto Taromaru received the B.E. and M.E. degrees in electronics engineering from the Tokyo Institute of Technology in 1985 and 1987, respectively, and the Ph.D. degree from Kyushu Institute of Technology in 1997.

In 1987, he joined Kyushu Matsushita Electric Corporation, a company of Panasonic, where he worked on the development of wireless communication devices. Between 2001 and 2004, he was with Kyushu Sangyo University, where he was an Associate Professor in the Department of Electronics. From 2004 to 2010, he was with ATR Wave Engineering Laboratories, Kyoto, and was the head of the Department of Wireless Communication Systems. In 2010, he joined Fukuoka University, where he is currently a professor in the Department of Electronics and Computer Science. He served as Editor-in-Chief of IEICE Transactions on Communications during 2018—2020, and he has served as Editor-in-Chief of IEICE Communications Express since 2020.

His research interests include radio communication systems, especially transceiver architectures, diversity, and adaptive antenna systems. Dr. Taromaru is a member of IEEE.
