The special section is a joint project with NOLTA Society in collaboration with the Steering Committee of The 2021 Nonlinear Science Workshop (December 6–December 8, 2021: <https://nls2021.org/>). The special section invites papers from researchers who were qualified to present their original works in The 2021 Nonlinear Science Workshop. The major part of this special section will address recent progress in the field of nonlinear theory and its applications. Topics include but are not limited to:

Papers submitted to this Special Section must have been submitted to and accepted for presentation at The 2021 Nonlinear Science Workshop before submission. The papers will be peer-reviewed and handled by the editorial committee of the Special Section. The review process is “Fast Track Review” that is specially designed for the joint project with NOLTA Society and The 2021 Nonlinear Science Workshop. The deadline for the paper submission is **October 18, 2021**. Eligible authors are requested to carefully follow the submission process:

- (1) Check the latest information of the call for papers at https://www.ieice.org/eng_r/information/schedule/journals.php?type=05 .
- (2) Prepare the manuscript according to the guidelines described on the web page: <http://www.nolta.ieice.org/data/authors.html> .
The LATEX style file and template file may be downloaded from the web page.
Papers **do not exceed 6 pages** of an A4-sized PDF file.
- (3) Submit the manuscript and agree to the "Copyright Transfer and Page Charge Agreement" using the IEICE paper submission system at: https://review.ieice.org/regist/regist_baseinfo_e.aspx .
Authors should choose “[NW] Nonlinear Science Workshop on the Journal” as a “Journal/Section”.
Do not choose “[Regular-EN]”.

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The maximum length of each paper: 6 pages.

The special article charges:

One of the authors is a member of IEICE: 30,000 JPY + TAX
Otherwise: 33,000 JPY + TAX
