Submission Guidelines:

Submit papers using the IEICE online submission web site https://review.ieice.org/regist/regist_baseinfo_e.aspx by **February 23, 2024 (extended)**. Choose the “[Special-SM] Smart Multimedia & Communication Systems” as a “Journal/ Section” on the online submission page. We accept papers only in PDF format.

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Manuscripts should be prepared according to the style guidelines for the IEICE Transactions (See https://www.ieice.org/eng/shiori/mokuji_ess.html). In this special section, the length of the manuscript should be no longer than eight printed pages for a PAPER and two printed pages for a LETTER (For the initial submission of a LETTER, the number of pages excluding references is at most 4). Submissions that do not follow the above instructions will not be accepted. The term for revision after the review process might be shortened, although it is usually 60 days' long.

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
