Special Section on Recent Advances in Nonlinear Problems

The open-access journal “Nonlinear Theory and Its Applications (NOLTA), IEICE” (indexed in Scopus and in the Directory of Open Access Journals) with a Journal Impact Factor of 0.6 (provided by Clarivate in June 2026) welcomes you to submit papers for the Special Section on Recent Advances in Nonlinear Problems, which will be included in the issue published in April 2027. Submission of the paper presented at a recent IEICE Technical Conference on Nonlinear Problems (NLP) is strongly encouraged. The papers are expected to be well-polished according to the discussion at the NLP conferences. However, presentation of the paper at the NLP Conference is not mandatory for its inclusion in this Special Section. The scope of this Special Section includes all topics related to nonlinear problems.

Papers submitted to this Special Section will be peer-reviewed and handled by the editorial committee of the Special Section. The deadline for the paper submission is **Oct 3, 2026**. Prospective authors are requested to carefully follow the submission process:

The new two-column author template file may be downloaded from the web page. Please note that the manuscript must include several additional statements, which of them are mandatory. Papers do not usually exceed 30 pages of an A4-sized PDF file.
- (3) Submit the manuscript and agree to the " Copyright Transfer, and Article Processing Charge Agreement, and Notices from the IEICE and Privacy Policy " using the IEICE paper submission system at:

Authors should choose “[Special-NP] Recent Advances in Nonlinear Problems” as a “Journal/Section”. Do not choose “[Regular-EN]”.
