

Noboru Babaguchi received B.E., M.E., and Ph.D. degrees in communication engineering from Osaka University, Japan, in 1979, 1981, and 1984, respectively. He is currently a professor and the dean of the Graduate School of Engineering, Osaka University. His research interests include image/video analysis, multimedia computing, and intelligent systems. He has recently been researching privacy protection methods for visual information and the security and fabrication of multimedia. He has published over 250 journal and conference papers and several textbooks.

He served as a guest editor of the IEEE Transactions on Information Forensics and Security, Special Issue on Intelligent Video Surveillance for Public Security and Personal Privacy. He also served as a general co-chair of MMM2008, a general co-chair of ACM Multimedia 2012, a track co-chair of ICPR2012, an area chair of IEEE ICME2013, and an honorary co-chair of ACM ICMR2018. He is a fellow of the IEICE, a vice president of the ITE, a senior member of the IEEE, and a member of the ACM, IPSJ, and JSAI.
