Posting on IEICE Proceedings Series (IEICE International Conference Contents Archive System)

The IEICE Proceedings Series archives the contents of international conferences hosted and co-sponsored by the Institute of Electronics, Information and Communication Engineers (IEICE), and possible to open widely to mainly universities and libraries research institutions throughout Japan.

The IEICE aims to open valuable scientific manuscripts, such as for international conferences, available to the world at a low price and to contribute to the progress of science and technology.

- (A) to (C) are required for posting on IEICE Proceedings Series.
- (A) IEICE Proceedings Series registration application sheet
- (B) Metadata files for international conference (3 types: common file, session file, Article file)
- (C) Text files of manuscripts at the international conference (pdf file)

[Posting Fee]

- In case of closed access (available only for Subscription Members (libraries) or individual members who have applied for subscription), posting fee is free. All contents will be planned to become open access after 10 years from the content archived.
- In case of open access, the posting fee is 300,000 JPY or the total number of pages x 1,000 JPY, whichever is higher. For example, if there are 20 contents 4-page manuscripts, 80 pages x 1,000 JPY = 80,000 JPY, so the posting fee is 300,000 JPY. If there are 100, 6-page manuscripts, 600 pages x 1,000 JPY = 600,000 JPY, so the posting fee will be 600,000 JPY.
- In case of partial open access, if the open access pages do not exceed 20% of the total pages, the posting fee will be 1,000 JPY x open pages. If it exceeds 20% of the total pages, the posting fee is the higher of 300,000 JPY or the total number of pages x 1,000 JPY.

[Remarks]

• IEICE Proceedings Series can include contents from international conference proceedings for which the IEICE is a sponsor or a joint sponsor, technical co-sponsor etc. Also, the IEICE must hold the copyright (There is no problem in case of sharing with other academic societies, etc.).

If the IEICE does not hold the copyright and the author holds the copyright (for example, presentation materials for invited lectures), choose either of the following ①, ② or ③.

- ① Exclude from the search target (do not include manusctipt B and C above)
- ② Limit the use of bibliographic information (such as title and author name) to those that the author can approve.
- 3 Consult the IEICE office for granting exclusive use of rights
