

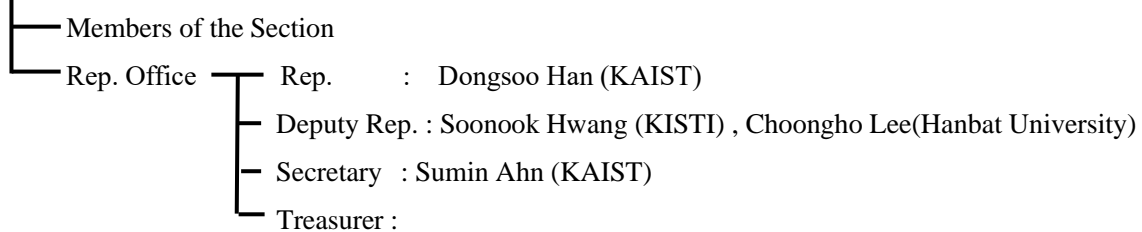
Annual Activity Report of IEICE Korea (Information) Section
