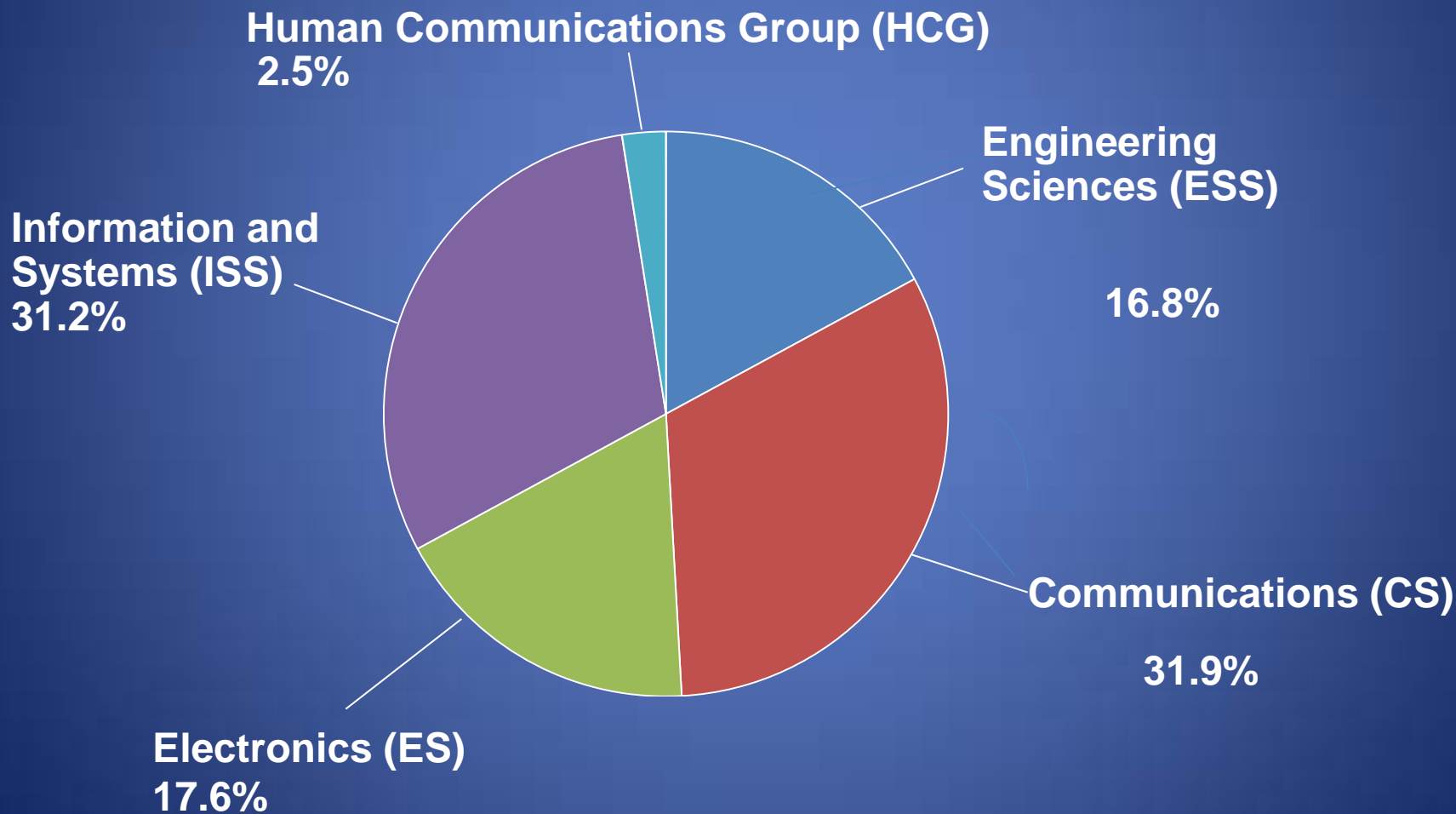
IEICE Organization



IEICE Membership Structure



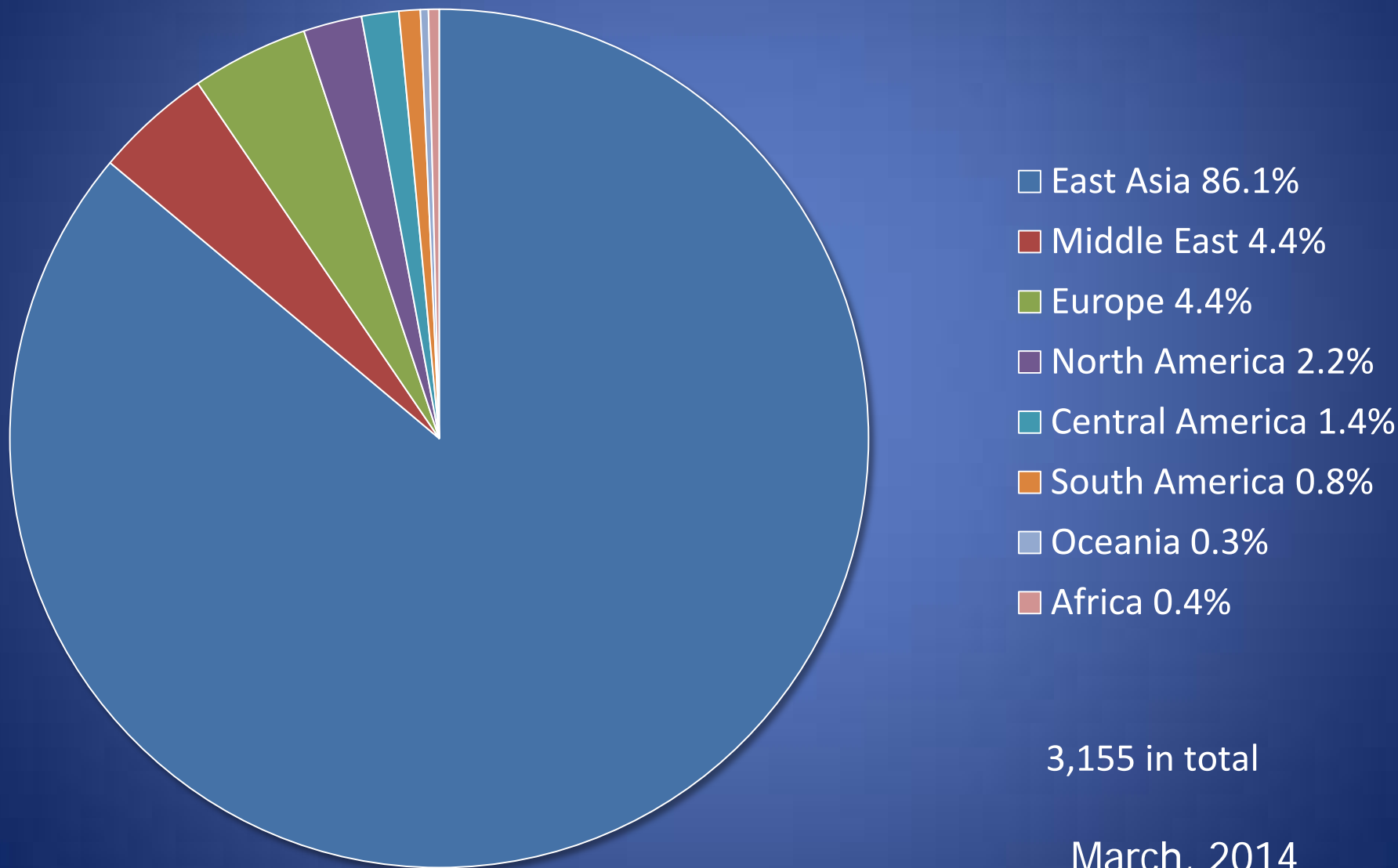
IEICE Membership of Societies & Group



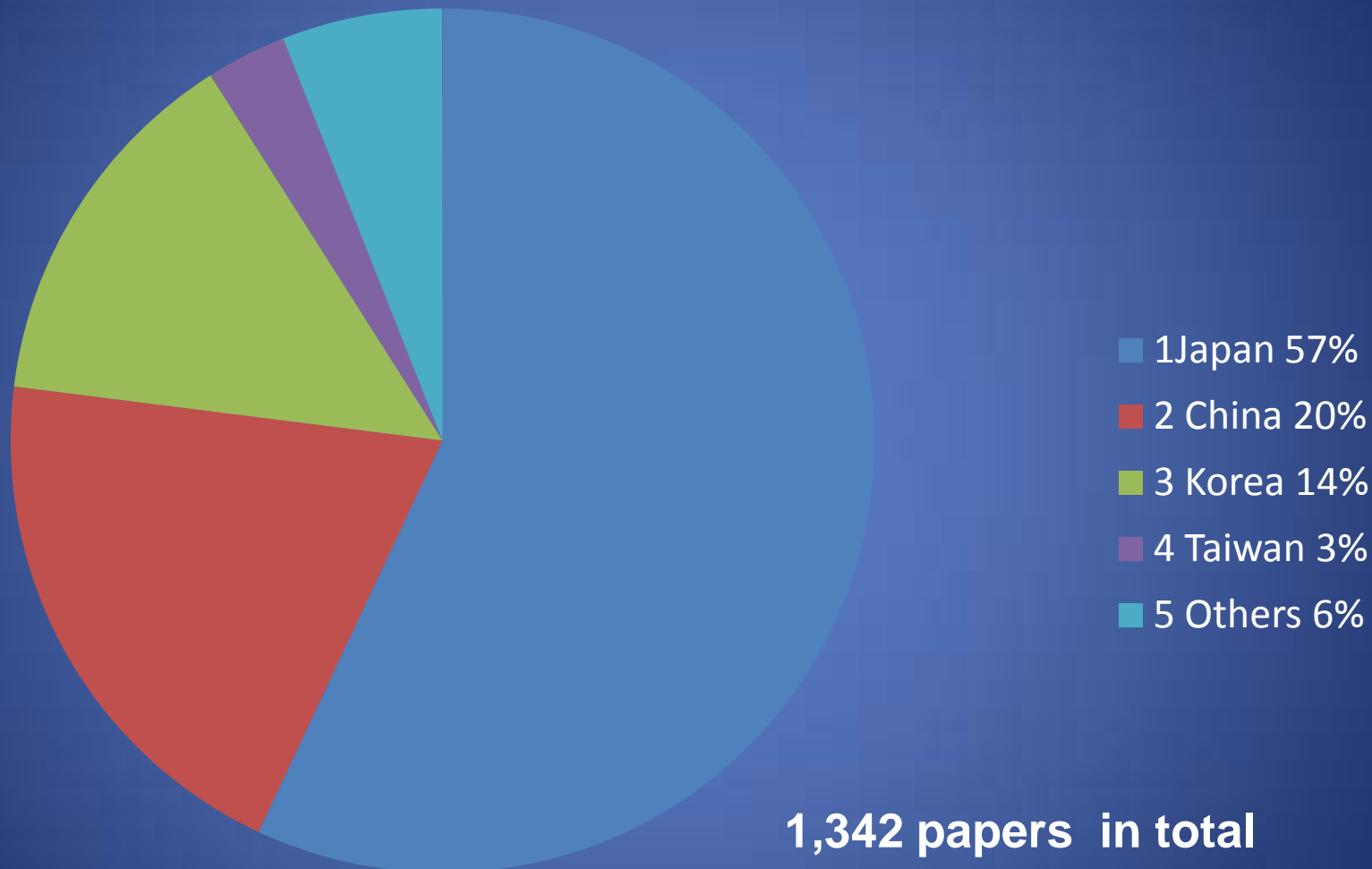

IEICE Overseas Membership



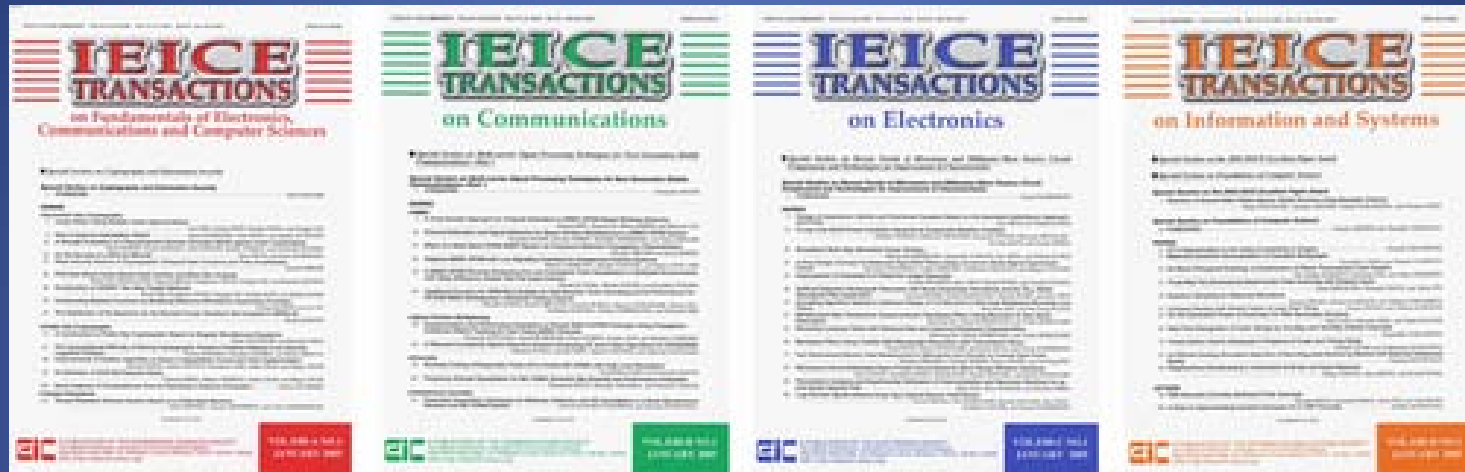
Published Papers (English Transactions)

The average time of receipt-to-publication is 65 days.

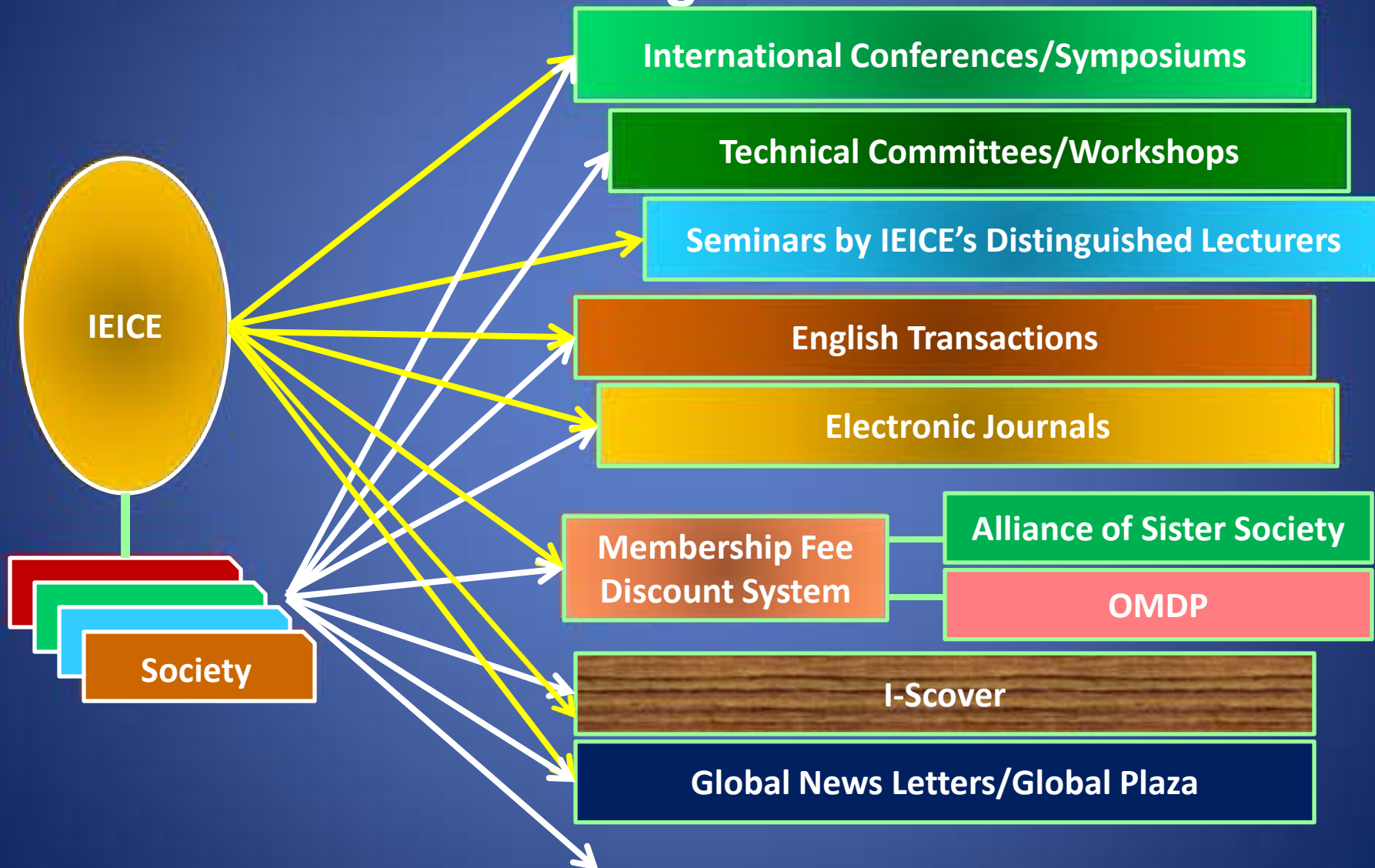

 - Assign more number of international distinguished lecturer
 - Encourage to use and to enhance I-Scover
 - Distribute list of participants including email addresses
