

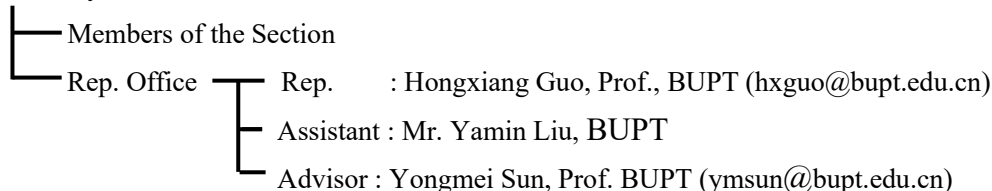
Annual Activity Report of IEICE Beijing Section
