Guidelines for IEICE Ambassadors' use of SNS

(Adopted by the Service Committee on November 29, 2022)

- 1. When you send out information clearly stating that you are a member of the IEICE, understand that the information you submit can affect the IEICE and that you must have self-awareness and take responsibility for it.
- 2. Comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including copyrights, portrait rights, and trademark rights.
- 3. Do not post messages that violate the rights of people related to the IEICE, contents that annoy others, or badmouth others. In addition, information that has a risk of threatening the safety of the members of IEICE should not be sent out.
- 4. Be sure to use accurate information. Also, careful consideration shall be given to avoid any misunderstanding of the content of such information. Understand that the information posted on the network cannot be completely deleted, even once it has been made public.
- 5. Handle messages from others with a receptive and empathetic attitude, recognizing that the information you send out will lead to the reputation of the IEICE. If you have wrongfully caused harm or created misunderstandings, you must respond with sincerity and be aware of your behavior in a responsible manner.
- 6. Avoid sending out messages on dates and at times that may be sensitive, such as major disasters or incidents.
- 7. The following information shall not be communicated.
 - (1) Information containing profane language (2) Information that discriminates or promotes discrimination based on race, ideology, religion, etc. (3) Information that encourages illegal acts and/or illegal acts (4) Information that leads to gossip or rumors (5) Links to websites containing indecent content (6) Any other information offensive to public order and morals (7) Controversial topics such as politics, religion, and ideology
